All games must begin and end on time. Please plan to arrive at the field 15 minutes prior to game time. Games will consist of four 12-minute quarters, with 2 minutes between quarters and a 5-minute halftime. Teams are 6 v 6 (including goalie). Please allow equal playing time for all players. The team listed first is the home team and is responsible for providing a #4 game ball. ***Players and parents are responsible for their trash.***

Substitutions are allowed as follows: At the end of each quarter; after a goal; and on a goal kick (not on a corner kick). Substitutions are also allowed prior to your team's throw in with notification to the referee. (If a game is stopped to allow for substitution for an injured player, the other team may also substitute one player.) If a player is injured and wants to leave the game, he must ask the referee to stop the game.

Please make every effort to play all games as scheduled. If you must cancel a game, it is the responsibility of the home team coach to contact Ted Doherty so that we can cancel the referee. Please use your best judgment and creativity to get each game played as scheduled (i.e. play 4v4). **Coaches should check the Natick Soccer Website (www.naticksoccer.org) in the event of inclement weather to check for field closings/game cancellations.**

Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their players, parents and spectators, and all are expected to be respectful of the referee and players at all times. Please introduce yourself to the ref before the game. *No coach, parent or spectator should have any contact with the referee during or after the game.* Natick Soccer maintains a policy of Zero Tolerance towards the referees. No parent should yell at the ref, and no coach should express displeasure with a call, even if it is a bad call.
